Work has started this week on stage 1 of the precinct plan for the Cathedral.

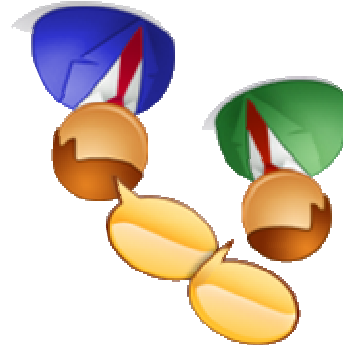
