Two weeks ago I mentioned the clerestory memorial window to Canon George and Mrs Carver. It depicts the risen Christ at Galilee. It's on the northern wall of the Chancel.

I didn't realise how beautiful it actually is until I sat opposite it last Sunday at Evensong. Make sure you have a look at it.

Canon Carver was the Vice Dean at the Cathedral from 1914 to 1921. There are records of Canon Carver visiting people during WW1 to tell them of the death of a loved one. During his time the Cathedral was consecrated (1916) by Bishop Radford after its debt was paid.

HOME COMMUNIONS

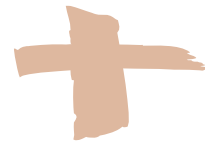
CELEBRANT: (N), we send you out to share Communion with those unable to come to Church.
