## MINISTRY OF HOSPITALITY

In St. Saviour's we have The Lady Chapel. It is an ancient tradition to have such a chapel in churches. In this chapel we remember Mary and we are also able to think about our mothers. Why is the carpet blue? There is no official colour for Mary but blue is often associated with her.

Here are some thoughts... are there others?

Dark blue was the colour of

Byzantine empresses so maybe there is a link with the saying that Mary is the queen of heaven.

Lapis lazuli is a blue precious stone that has sometimes been more precious than gold maybe blue indicates the significance of Mary.

Lighter shades of blue perhaps refer to the sky where it is thought heaven is.

Visitors are often interested in the fact that the Lady Chapel is used for three services each week day. Perhaps you would like to attend one of these?
