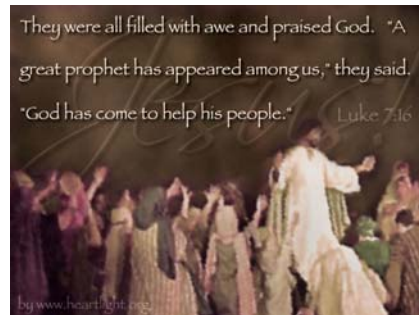

MINISTRY OF HOSPITALITY

In St. Saviour's we have The Lady Chapel. It is an

ancient tradition to have such a chapel in churches. In this chapel we remember Mary and we are also able to think about our mothers.

On the West Wall of the chapel is a relatively large window that depicts three events from the New Testament – the marriage at Cana, the miracle of the fishes and the story of the withered fig tree.

The window was funded by the laity associated with the Cathedral as a memorial to Dean Sowerby, the first Dean of St Saviour's. When he was Dean the present building did not exist. It is a window that is easily viewed close up so have a look at it.

Visitors are often interested in the fact that the Lady Chapel is used regularly for weekday services. Perhaps you would like to attend one of these?

On the 13th July there will be a lunch for guides and minders so put the date in your diary.
