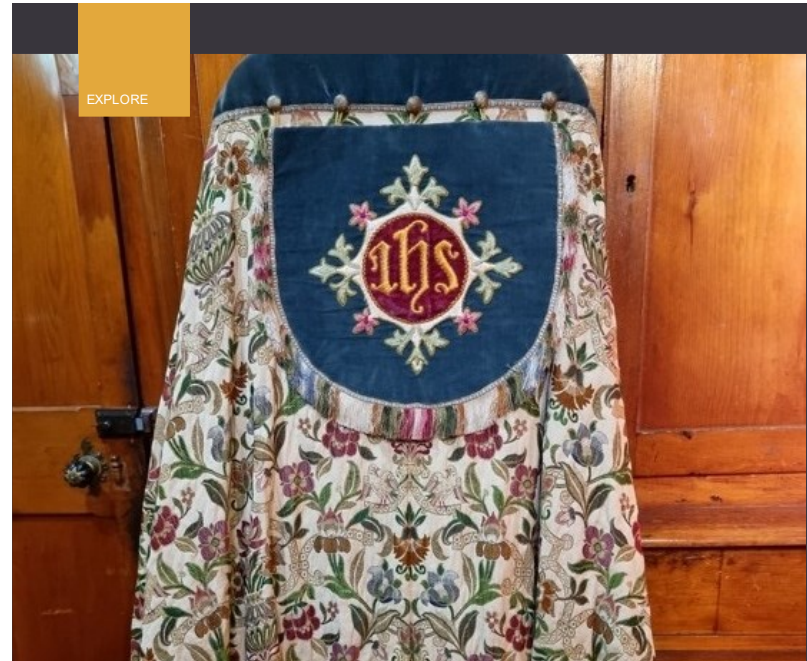

Elite Bellringers assemble in Goulburn

This coming week, following the Lilac City weekend, elite bellringers from around Australia and New Zealand will assemble right here in Goulburn.



Dr.Christopher O'Mahony, ringing master of St.Saviour's, says: "Goulburn has the proud boast of housing a magnificent ring of 12 bells—the only church in regional Australia to claim this. It is one of only eight complete rings of 12 bells in existence throughout Australia and New Zealand, and all the others are in capital cities. The bells at St.Saviour's Cathedral are very much part of the Goulburn community, having been originally installed in 1988 (in itself an exciting bicentennial project) with enormous local support and fundraising."

Throughout 2022, a number of bellringing events have been taking place to celebrate the 150th anniversary of our original eight bells. These bells came to Goulburn from their previous home—St.Mark's Church in Leicester, UK. When St.Mark's was declared redundant, Goulburn was able to snap up the bells and give them a new life in Australia. Those 8 bells, now name for ships that sailed in the First Fleet, were cast in 1872—exactly 150 years ago.

Dr.O'Mahony is delighted with the event taking place next week. **"From Tuesday afternoon 4th October, through to Thursday lunchtime 6th October** Goulburn bellringers will be hosting a special ringing tour. This includes expert ringers from Perth, Adelaide, Melbourne and Sydney, as well as Wellington in New Zealand. With some top class ringers visiting us, we can look forward to some really top class ringing. Rest assured, we have installed some very effective sound control, so rather than sounding intrusive the people of Goulburn should be treated to a delightful background soundscape throughout the event."

Stephen Relf, Tower Captain at St.Saviour's, says: "We believe that bells make a joyful sound, and we hope that the community will agree. In a way, bells are like an external choir. Listening to bells encourages us to stop, to look up, and to take stock of the world around us. They take us out of ourselves and lift us above the daily grind. They encourage us to appreciate so much that is beautiful, and to count our blessings, especially in our currently uncertain world. We hope you like the ringing!"

If anyone would like to come and see the ringers and the bells in action, there's an opportunity on Wednesday 5th October from 5pm. All welcome
